Such membership is valid for a maximum of 3 months for the work and location (s) specified in the temporary membership and may be held for a maximum of three 3-month periods in a year, or nine 3-month periods in 10 years. Temporary permits require the approval of the Registration Committee. The committee meets approximately every two months. Meeting dates can be found on our website.
