

Transferring From Another Canadian Province

Only Full (R.P.F.) Members or the equivalent registered in another Canadian province may transfer to the OPFA. To apply for Full Membership you will need to submit:

1. A [Full Membership Application Form](#);
2. The application fee-refer to the current [Fee Schedule](#);
3. Resumé and;
4. Letter of Good Standing (email is acceptable) from the province with whom you are currently registered.

You will be approved for Full Membership, however, depending on your circumstances you will have one or two conditions on your certificate. You will have 6 months to satisfy the conditions after which your certificate will be revoked. Those conditions are to:

1. Report that you have completed a Personal Practice Focus and a Learning Plan. You will be provided with more information at the time of your acceptance;
2. Successfully complete the [Ontario Forest Policy and Legislative Framework Bridge Training – Module 4](#). This requirement and the possible exemptions from it are explained in the [Ontario Forest Policy and Legislative Requirement Policy](#).

Membership Fees

Refer to the [Fee Schedule](#) for annual membership fees. Membership fees are prorated from the date of your approval based on our fiscal year which is December 1-November 30.
