- Oversee compliance within the Prince Albert Area including field investigations and responses;
- Lead public consultations of forest management with stakeholders, First Nations and Métis communities, agencies, media, and the public;
- Participate in the development of policy and provide forest policy direction and forest management expertise to other branches and government ministries, and support senior ministry staff on forest management and policy issues related to operations and operational planning; and
- Work with other resource management specialists to develop solutions aligned with the Ministry's ecosystem management principles.
