

Transferring From Another Canadian Province

If you are a Full Member in another province and wish to apply for Full (R.P.F.) membership in the OPFA you will need to:

1. Submit an email that you have a [Personal Practice Focus and a Learning Plan](#) saved in your personal files;
2. Provide proof that you have successfully completed the [Ontario Forest Policy and Legislative Framework Bridge Training – Module 4](#) or have transcripts submitted to us directly from the issuing institution that show that you completed an Ontario [CFAB](#) (Canadian Forestry Accreditation Board) accredited program within the last 5 years. This requirement is explained in the [Ontario Forest Policy and Legislative Requirement Policy](#).

The module linked above is currently closed for registration, as it is being updated by the University. However, you can also meet this requirement by completing the [OPFA Interim Forest Policy Module](#), for more information about the interim module please see the link provided.

3. Submit a [Full Membership Application Form](#);
4. Submit the application fee via e-transfer to opfa@opfa.ca (include your name in the message), cheque payable to Ontario Professional Foresters Association or [online](#)-refer to the current [Fee Schedule](#);
5. Submit a resumé and;
6. Have a Letter of Good Standing (email is acceptable) submitted to us directly from the province with whom you are currently registered.



Annual Membership Fees
